From the Pastor's Desk

A few weeks ago, 23 of our HOPE quilts had the privilege of being selected to make the trip to Roanoke College in Salem, Virginia. These quilts will be given to the International students who have just arrived on campus. These students come from countries all over the world, get off the plane with just their suitcases and a few personal belongings, eager to start their new journey in America. We are fortunate to have the opportunity to give them a "Welcome to the US" gift that will remind them of the support and encouragement that is behind their Lutheran education from sister congregations. Over the years we have received many wonderful "thank yous" and positive comments about our quilts. They are surely headed for many adventures with their new owners, full of hope and promise.

Property Update – August 2016

Brothers and Sisters of Hope:

During my temple talk on Sunday (7/31) I asked for your help. A donation of time and a donation of treasure. As a result of that temple talk we have had some movement in both areas. I thank you for all your effort thus far and your future efforts.

Now to give you an update on what we have been doing to keep our church and property looking good and functional:

- <u>Painting</u>: The first phase of a 2-year painting program has been completed. We just completed painting the cross in the front yard, the main office, Pastor Santos' office, the nursery and Fellowship Hall. The goal of this program is to give all areas of our church a fresh coat of paint.
- <u>Driveway/Parking Lot Repair</u>: The first phase of our pothole repair program will be completed by Friday (9/2). This phase will focus on repairing the more serious potholes located at the entrance/ exit areas. We may need to do some additional repair work near term but the goal will be to perform a Driveway/Parking Lot Resurfacing project within the next few years.
- <u>Sanctuary/Narthex Cleaning</u>: It has been many years since our sanctuary and narthex have had a thorough cleaning from top (ceiling & wall) to bottom (pews & carpet).
- Repair and Update Parking Lot Lights: At least one of the parking lot lights is nonfunctioning because of a break in the electrical conduit that goes to that unit. This will require laying a new conduit to that unit. In addition, we are looking at replacing all old sodium vapor lights with more energy efficient type lights.
- Additional mold remediation in some of the class rooms
- Tree removal and landscaping

As I stated in my Temple Talk last month, the need for these projects is immediate and is outside the current budget for this year. We do not want the repairs to our church's facilities to be delayed to the point that we are having similar problems as Metro is having with their repair program.

- Your donations of treasure should be marked for "HLC Property Facilities Repair".
- Your donation of time, come talk to me and we will get you engaged in helping with Hope's facilities.

I would like to leave you with a parting thought. It is from **Haggai 2:9**: "The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith the LORD of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts." This house, our church of God, is a place where we come to hear His words and receive His peace. Please help in this process by helping to keep Hope Lutheran Church a pleasant place to worship.
